Information and Privacy Commissioner to release special report

VICTORIA – On Tuesday, July 22, 2014, at 9:30 a.m., B.C. Information and Privacy Commissioner Elizabeth Denham will release a special report, entitled *A Failure to Archive: Recommendations to Modernize Government Records Management*.

The report explores three distinct issues in archiving and their implications for access to information in British Columbia: the failure to archive government's paper records from 2003 to the present day; the lack of archiving infrastructure for government's electronic records; and the need for reform of B.C.'s antiquated legislation governing records management.
