Commissioner to release report on privacy law compliance by BC medical clinics

VICTORIA—On Wednesday, September 25, 2019 at 9:30am, Information and Privacy Commissioner Michael McEvoy will release a compliance review on how medical clinics throughout British Columbia are meeting their legal obligations to protect personal information.

The Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner (OIPC) review looked at the privacy management programs, privacy policies, and collection and safeguarding of personal information at 22 BC clinics to gauge compliance with the *Personal Information Protection Act*.
